<u>Currently dues are \$30.00 for new members</u> and \$25 for returning members if paid before July 1st. Dues for returning members paid after July 1st is \$30. **If a member is delinquent in paying dues, and does not provide the required number of service hours, they will be removed from membership.**

Six service hours during the week of the quilt show are required of each member. Members are also encouraged to serve on guild and show committees, participate in raffle ticket sales & community service projects, periodically provide refreshments for meetings and help with meeting set up and clean-up.

GUESTS are welcome at all guild meetings and are required to register pertinent information in the Guest book. Guest fees are determined by the program committee. Current guest fees are \$5.00. **All non members are required to pay the guest fee**. There is no guest fee for June dinner/reorganization meeting. (See a board member for June dinner meeting details.) Programs and fees are made public prior to each meeting. A schedule of yearly events is available.
